

Mom of stealing money, hoping nobody catches me. Terrified. Have to be extra nice. v. guilty. I will go out + spend it. If I have money I'm safe. Dreadfully guilty. Terrified of F. finding out. He does find out. (I do it several times).

Station with £1 note. They ask for name + address etc. M. picks me up. Did you take it? Wait for F. utterly miserable. Heat.

I stay home. Car not there. I have to wait. Dragging. So long. Feeling awful inside. Hope he won't come.

He calls me. Hairbrush in pocket. Bend over. I'm going to spank you. Freeze. Take off trousers + underpants + hits me. I scream. Its humiliating + it hurts. Aged 10.

Guilt about money. I haven't earned it. Its been given to me. I wish he'd give me attention, knowledge of how to handle money. I feel guilty - I've accepted it. It dominates my life now. Its there - if I want something, it is there. I take S. on holiday w. guilt at spending the money. It goes back to Father.

Shop in W. Kirby. Bought a waxed orange 7/6 - what for? its a candle. I might be found out. I stole the money - I can't take it back. Can't take it home. Don't know what to do with this useless orange.

Meeting F. He asks about business. He's valuing me. But is it just checking up on me?

(Tears) I'm frightened, lonely, no friends. Nobody likes me. I have more money. Nobody likes me.

← I shouldn't, but if I've got it, I feel a kind of fullness. Its a 3d bit. I've got 3d; I can do something with it. But I've taken it, not been given it. Can go to sweetshop with friends. If I have money, they are my friends.

Money = food. Something I can get hold of. The need is in me, it is an attraction. I can buy what I want. I want people to like me. I want to be a centre of attention.

I am bottom of class. I have to go to bed earlier + I am smaller than anybody. I only have friends round once a week. I'm lonely. I want to do things so people will notice me. To show I am as interesting as they. I am trying to hook attention. Everyone likes ice creams. I can buy them for friends + I'm in. They like my money, not me, but its better than nothing.

F. asking about money. He's v. roundabout but I know what he means. House values, etc. He's so quick to take over legalities etc. Am I going to be found out? I haven't got all the money left. Speaking again?

(God gives the money.) Its for your further development. You can create a centre with it. A place in which to work + experience feedback from it. R. feels he's failed. But its a learning, and later an earning process.

you have to be trained before you can be called to account. The guilt is in the money. The cause is not being warned. Embryonic stress on money. F. also took money. There is a stress on money in the line.

Be aware of problem, + it dissolves.

F. compares and counts. He likes counting. It's habitual. He values his life in terms of how much he has given. He thinks himself a divine distributor. It also binds people to him. The more there are, the more important he is.

Without them he feels a bit of a waif. Frustrated because people feel the shell + not the nut. It should be planted. It's renewable. (F. - reason for money gift).

Money is their inheritance. I am their trustee. I am concerned they use it wisely. It's getting out of my control. I'll keep tabs on it, to make sure nothing stupid happens.

R. - money is necessary as a source of hard lessons. I have to learn economy. It works on laws. Spend no more than you need. Guilt at failure there in the past. It's more controlled now. To do with tel. with wife. Her expectation is total provision. If I don't, I am deficient. Then I am frightened she will leave me (think to ice cream buying).

Intelligence says new camera is necessary for SUR. Money involved not properly researched. The most expensive is not necessarily best. Not sufficient research.

Help, but based on sounder knowledge. I am willing to help but you need expert help + hands on experience. Wait til after your course.

As long as her point of being the best + needing the best is acknowledged, that is OK.
